* **Recovered Stolen Auto** – Ralston Ct. –
I was on patrol when I located a stolen vehicle parked, unoccupied. The stolen vehicle, a black 2020 Ford Escape was confirmed stolen by Southcom Dispatch. I contacted, Merrillville Police, who reported the vehicle stolen earlier in the day. They only wanted the vehicle recovered. The vehicle was unlocked with no key inside

* **Suspicious Person** - Officers were dispatched to the area of 5800 Prairie Rose Drive reference a male subject soliciting. Officer made contact with the male subject. He advised he works for Power Exterior. The subject advised he was done working for the day and he was advised about soliciting in Schererville.

* **Suspicious Incident** - I was dispatched to 25 E Joliet St, Schererville Police Department, in reference to an information report involving suspicious activity with homeowner's vehicle. RP stated that her parents received a call from a neighbor stating that her car was turning on and off at approximately 02:35 am on 10/26/2022 but she never saw any individuals and no damage was done to the vehicle. The R/P stated that her parents are out of town and requested extra patrol for the area. The R/P stated that she will be checking the residence on a daily basis.

* **Suspicious Person** – E. Lincoln Dr. The R/P came to the PD to report that someone she sees at food banks around the region has people following her. She does not know who the female is or who is following her. She states she sees weird vehicles around her house and believes its people who are following her. She was advised to call the PD the next time there was an unknown vehicle around her residence.

* **Suspicious Persons** - I responded for a juvenile problem on St. John Rd. Upon arrival, I spoke with the R/P about the incident. He said that about ten minutes prior to calling "9-1-1" a group of perceived juveniles banged on his side window knocking down one of the decorations. The window itself was not damaged. He explained that he heard multiple voices and that a similar incident happened the year prior.





- * **Criminal Mischief** – Stephens Park. Officers were dispatched to Stephens Park in regards to vandalism on the playground. Officers arrived and noticed yellow graffiti on the pavilion and on the play equipment at the playground.
- * **Criminal Mischief** – James Wittchen Dr., I observed the complainant's truck to have several impact marks on the windshield as well as several broken eggs on and around the truck. I made contact with the complainant, The R/P stated that when he returned home from work, he observed 8 or 9 juveniles with ages ranging from approximately 9 to 13 years old running away from his truck. The R/P stated he recognized some of the children from previous altercations with the children. The R/P provided the address for the location of two juveniles that he observed running away from his truck.

Ordinance of the Week:

SEC. 4-103 NOISE REGULATIONS AT OUTDOOR EVENTS.

Schererville, IN - Code of Ordinances

...Any outdoor event which has any type of outside music, loud speakers or other form of amplification must end said music or amplification no later than 11:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday and no later than 10:00 p.m. on Sundays. Undue or excessively loud music or other noise resulting from the operation of an outdoor event will not be permitted and is subject to regulation by the Chief of Police of the Town of Schererville or an authorized representative from the Schererville Police Department.
