* **PROPERTY DAMAGE** – Cynthia Ct. Officers responded to the above location in reference to an unknown subject running from the complainant's residence. Officers located the involved juveniles in the area on a golf cart. The juveniles advised that they were playing ding dong ditch. Officers instructed the juveniles to cease their activities and return to their residences before further police action was taken..

* **PROPERTY DAMAGE** – Barrington Ct. - This officers was dispatched to the above area in reference to a vehicles window being broken out. I arrived on scene and spoke with the complainant who stated that at approximately 6:39 AM two unknown parties came up onto his driveway and broke his passenger side front window of his vehicle. Complainant showed video footage of the incident.

* **SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT** – Winding Trail - I assisted St. John Police in locating shot fired in the area. As the area in question is close to the border of Schererville, I felt it appropriate to assist. Upon arrival, St. John Police had located the cause of the sound, which was a dry ice bomb

***CRIMINAL MISCHIEF** – Tate Dr - On 1/7/24 at approximately 1312 hrs, I was dispatched to Tate Dr in reference to damage to a fence. Upon arrival, I spoke with the RP. The RP stated that sometime between 11 PM and 12 AM on 1/6/24, his dog began barking at the backyard. RP advised that when the backyard was checked, he found that (2) fence planks had been pushed in from St John Rd. RP advised that he fixed the plants but the tops were cracked. RP showed me a picture on his phone of the planks pushed out. RP advised he does have cameras but they did not have the right angle to catch the suspects on video.

***CRIMINAL MISCHIEF** – Willowbrook Dr – The RP advised that around 08:30, him and his family were sitting in their living area and heard loud bangs in the front of the house. When they went to go look, they saw a black Chevrolet Impala, leaving from their residence. Mike also saw several eggs dripping from his windows. Suspects were located and investigation is ongoing.

The Schererville Police Department encourages our residents to deposit un-used medications into the collection box that is located in our station lobby. The medication will be disposed of safely. **No sharps please.**

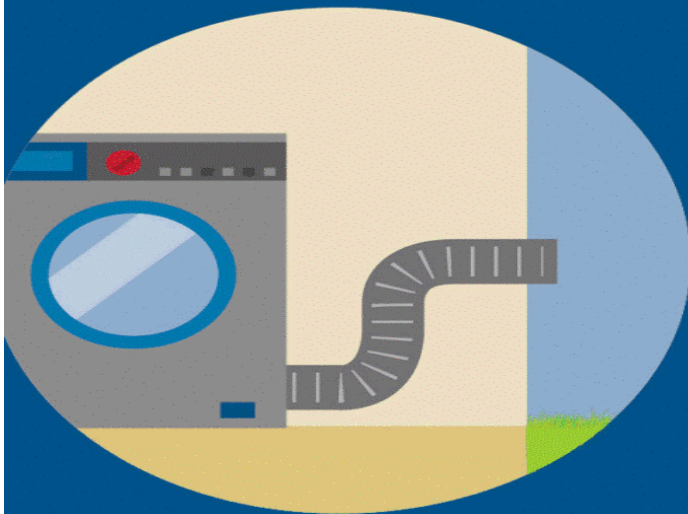

Sec. 8-62 Special Regulations for Street Work and Snow Removal. ¹⁷

a. Work. The Public Works Director is given the power to post temporary signs reading "**No Parking - Street Work**" along any street which he intends to sweep, clear, or work within the succeeding 24 hours. The street commissioner shall post every street that he intends to work with said signs prior to 4 PM of the preceding day.

All vehicles shall be removed before 7 AM of the day the street is to be worked.

b. Snow removal. No person shall park any vehicle on any street within the corporate limits of the town, whenever there is two (2") inches or more of snow thereon, until said snow is removed. Any vehicle which is parked on said streets when the depth of the snow exceeds two (2") inches may be towed away in the manner provided in this Chapter.

c. All streets are affected.
