Know Where to Go

When Sheltering from a Tornado

Top floor rooms DO NOT protect you.

Exterior rooms and rooms with windows DO NOT protect you.

NO PLACE OUTSIDE is safe from a tornado.

If you have no basement, move to an interior room with no windows.

Quickly move to your basement and bring your emergency supply kit.

What is the Difference Between a Flood watch & Flood Warning

Be Aware!



A Flood Watch is issued when conditions are:

- favorable for flooding.
- It does not mean flooding will occur, but it is possible.
- Continue to monitor the weather outlook and be prepared to seek shelter if need be.

Take Action!



A Flood Warning is issued when:

- Flooding is impending or currently occurring.
- Immediately evacuate and go to high ground.
- Stay out of floodwaters. They can contain dangerous hazards and waste.

Neighborhood Reports

- **3/4 – Theft – Rohrman Park** – Complainant stated credit cards were stolen from her vehicle while she was walking in Rohrman Park. Investigation ongoing.
- **3/7 – Suspicious Person – Ticonderoga** – A subject was observed going door to door. Responding officer located the subject. He stated he was soliciting for a repair company. He was informed door to door solicitation is not permitted in Schererville.
- **3/8 – Suspicious Person – Matterhorn Ct** – Report of a suspicious female walking around in the rain. Responding officer located the female who stated she was walking home from a local store. She was given a courtesy ride to her house. Nothing suspicious was observed.
- **3/8 – Suspicious Person – Fenway Ln** - Report of subjects, possibly juveniles, ringing doorbells in the area. Officers checked the area but no one was located outside.
- **3/10 – Property Damage – Austin Ave** – Complainants mailbox was struck and debris from a vehicle was located. Investigation ongoing.
- **3/11 – Open Burning – 85th & Burr** - Report of open burning in the area causing large amounts of smoke. Responding officer and Schererville FD located the source of the burning. A large pile of smouldering leaves was observed. The fire was extinguished and the resident was cited.

We received multiple reports of solicitors in several subdivisions but were not able to locate all of the subjects involved. As a reminder, door to door solicitation is not permitted in Schererville.

PATROL NOTIFICATIONS

As a courtesy, officers will attempt to notify residents of issues such as an open garage door, open car doors, or other unusual observations they may see while on patrol. Something like a garage door left open overnight could be an invitation for criminal activity. We try to let you know of these observations so that you may better protect your home and reduce the occurrence of criminal activity.
