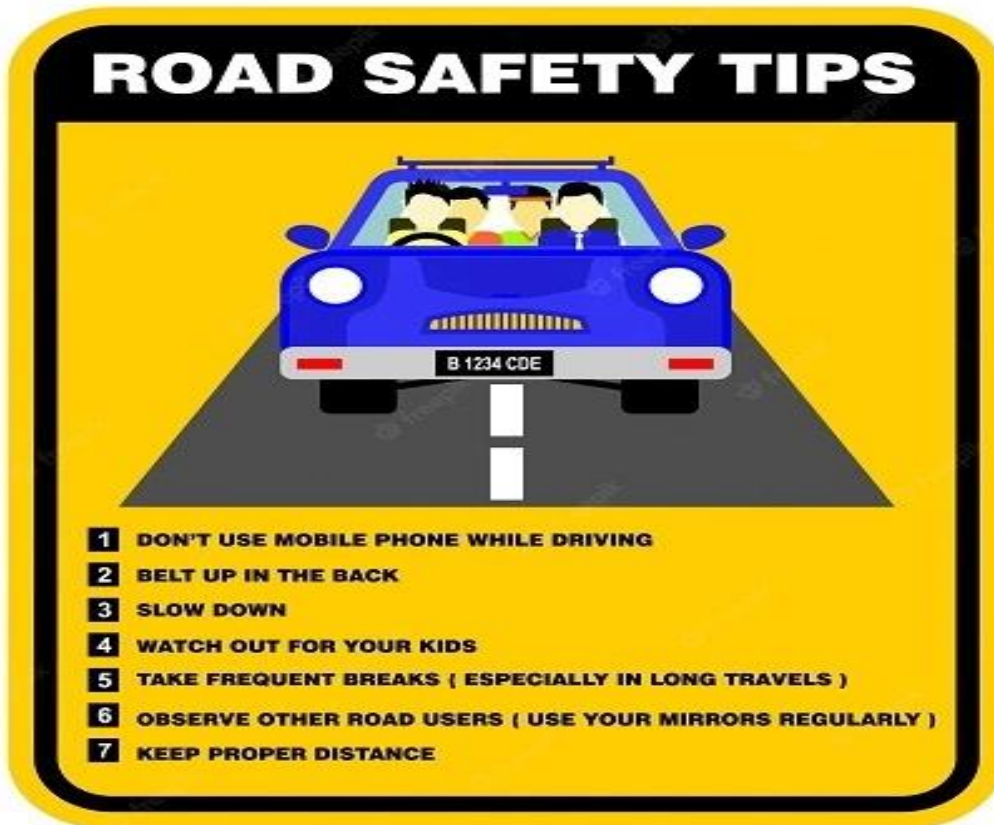

**REPORTS***** Suspicious Incident - W 77th Ave. & Naples Dr.**

*** Suspicious Person - Cypress Dr**

I received a call in reference to a suspicious incident on Cypress Drive. Southcom advised that the complainant stated she heard a knock on her back window. On arrival the rear of the house was checked, All windows and doors appeared secured and the yard was empty.

*** Suspicious Incident - 1434 Ceres Dr**

I received a call in reference to a suspicious incident on Ceres Dr. On arrival I spoke with the R/P, who stated that while she was outside, she observed a drone fly over her yard. She wanted to know if there was anything that can be done to find out who was controlling the drone. I advised the R/P that without knowing where it was coming from, or who was controlling it, nothing could be done at the moment. She was advised to contact us back if she could better locate where the drone was coming from or where it was returning to.

*** Weapon Offense - W Lincoln Hwy & Anna**

While on patrol, a traffic stop was initiated on a black Dodge Caliber at the intersection of W Lincoln Hwy and Anna St. It was discovered that the driver was a felon in possession of a firearm. The investigation was later referred to our detective bureau.

**Phone Company Scams**

A resident contacted us this week to advise that he received a phone call from someone claiming to be from his telephone company, and who advised him to press a number to receive a great deal. The resident did so, and then was connected with someone who asked him for his account number. The resident then hung up the phone.

ALWAYS REMEMBER TO NEVER give your personal information over the phone to anyone and to hang up right away if they ask for it or if they claim that you have a warrant, owe back taxes, or back utility bills. **Call 911 to speak with an officer if you are concerned.**



- * **Suspicious Vehicle** - Report of a red pickup sitting in the street for "months" without moving on Winterberry Lane. Upon arrival I made contact with the owner who was advised about the local ordinance about vehicles that don't move. Owner stated the brake line was messed up on it and he would move it off of the roadway. No police action taken at this time.
- * **Suspicious Person** – I was dispatched to Bach Rd in reference to a juvenile male black soliciting paintings for sale. RP said that the juvenile male was last seen walking West on Bach Road. The neighborhood was checked without success. I cleared without incident.
- * **Suspicious Incident** - Manchester Ln - The R/P noticed his 250lb crucifix knocked down. The R/P stated there was minimal damage and only a small chip on the left side. The R/P advised he only wanted a report on file in case neighbors call in reporting similar problems.
- * **Juvenile Problem** - 65TH AVE @ BURR ST Report of juveniles in the new subdivision located at 65th Ave and Burr St. They were located, and were just throwing rocks into a small pond on the property. Nothing seemed damaged or out of place. They were all asked to leave the area and did so without incident.
- * **Juvenile Problem** - Officers were dispatched to Buttercup St. reference to a juvenile problem. Upon arrival, officers made contact with the R/P. He reported four(4) juveniles went to his residence and knocked on his door and ran away. The R/P stated this is the third time the juveniles would go on his property and run off. Officers searched the area but were unable to locate the juveniles.

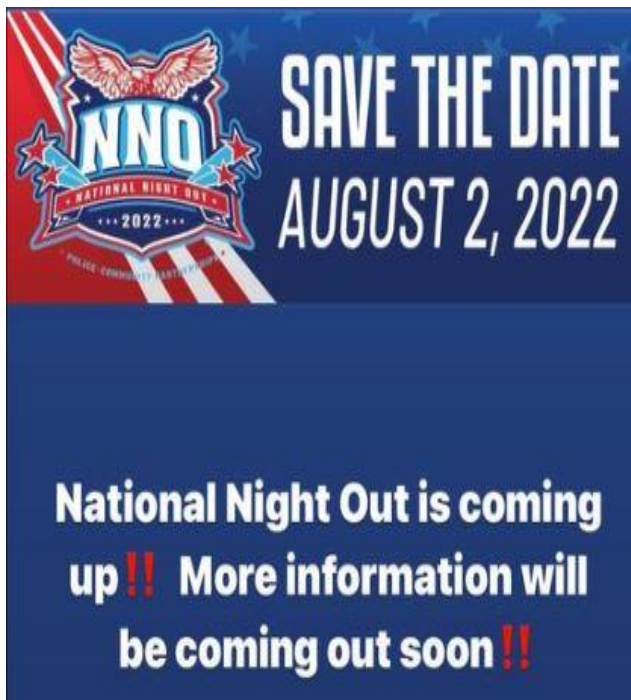

Ordinance of the Week:

Sec. 8-58 Standing or Parking Close to Curb.

- a. No person shall stand or park a vehicle on a roadway other than parallel with the edge of the roadway headed in the direction of the lawful traffic movement and with the right hand wheels within twelve (12) inches of the curb or the edge of the roadway.
- b. Angle parking in the town of Schererville, Indiana is prohibited.
