A reminder: July is National Vehicle Theft Prevention Month

How to Prevent Vehicle Theft

- Park in well-lit areas.
- Close and lock all windows and doors when you park.
- Keep valuables out of sight, such as in the glove box or trunk.
- Do not leave your keys in your vehicle.
- Do not leave the area while your vehicle is running.
- Some vehicles come equipped with an alarm and anti-theft system, but what if yours does not? Consider purchasing extra layers of protection for your vehicle if your manufacturer does not provide it. You can easily purchase an anti-theft system online or in a store.
