WALK-IN REGISTRATION: Registration for park programs can be done at the Schererville Community Center (500 E. Joliet St) and at the Clerk Treasurer’s Office at the Schererville Town Hall (10 E. Joliet St.). The Comm. Center is open Monday-Friday 8am-4:30pm. The Clerk’s office is open Monday-Friday 7:30am-4:30pm & Wednesday 7:30am-6:00pm.

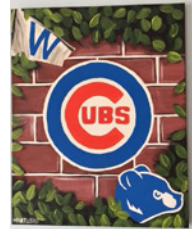
