COVID-19 REOPENING PLAN

The Schererville Parks Department takes the health and safety of our community very seriously. We want to thank you for your sacrifices. Please know that we are taking measures to slow the spread of the virus and we are consistently working to modify our plan of recovery and resilience. As we begin to open, certain protocols will be in effect to help minimize the threat of the virus and comply with the Governor's Executive Order # 20-28 for Stage 4.5.

Northwest Indiana is currently in Stage 4.5. Executive Orders have not been issued for Stages 5 at this time and thus are subject to change. Note that the schedule is subject to change based on the State's guidance for Lake County to enter into the next stage. We ask that you please be patient as we all work through each phase to get back on track. SCHEDULE:

Stage 4 June 12:

- All office/admin employees working from Community Center offices.
- o Community Center is open to public, (Face coverings are optional for visitors).
- Shelters, Public Restrooms, Ballfields, Basketball Courts, Skate Park, and Tennis Courts are open with social distancing.
- Playgrounds are open.
- Local sports leagues may resume games, sports camps, and tournaments following organizational protocols.
- NO Bounce Houses are allowed on park property.
- Drinking Fountains will be OFF.
- Shelter and Community Center rentals of no more than 100 people following CDC social distancing guidelines.
- Gatherings and events of up to 250 people allowed following CDC social distancing guidelines and with prior approval by Park Board.
- No special events or trips being offered by Park Department.
- Limited programming by Park Department may resume.

Stage 4.5 July 4:

- o Part-time rec staff return to work. Training to start week prior.
- Community Center is open to public. (Face coverings are optional for visitors).
- Public Restrooms, Playgrounds, Fields, Basketball Courts, Skate Park, and Tennis Courts are open.
- No trips being offered by the Park Department.
- Shelter and Community Center rentals no more than 100 people.
- Park Department to resume outdoor special events of over 250
- Gatherings and events over 250 people allowed following CDC social distancing guidelines and with prior approval by Park Board.
- NO Bounce Houses are allowed on park property.
- Summer youth programs start July 7.
- Drinking Fountains will be OFF.

Stage 5 July 18: (TENTATIVE)

- Community Center is open to public. (Face coverings are optional for visitors).
- Shelters, Public Restrooms, Playgrounds, Fields, Basketball Courts, Skate Park, and Tennis Courts are open.
- Shelter and Community Center rentals at full capacity.
- Trips may resume in the fall.
